Bills for service are rendered monthly and become due and payable on the 20th of the month following the period for which service is rendered. A late payment charge of 1 percent per month will be added to bills not paid within 20 days of issuance. This late payment charge will be applied to the total unpaid balance for utility service, including unpaid late payment charges. The late payment charge is applied to all customers. Utility customers may be given a written notice that the bill is overdue no sooner than 20 days after the bill is issued. Unless payment or satisfactory arrangements for payment are made within the next ten days, service may be disconnected.

## POWER COST ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE (PCAC)

All energy sales are subject to a positive or negative power cost adjustment charge equivalent to the amount of which the current cost of power (per kWh of sales) is greater or lesser than the base cost of power purchased and produced (per kWh). The base cost of power is currently \$0.0659 per kWh.

## PUBLIC BENEFIT

As required by state law, the Public Benefit fee is collected to fund low-income programs and energy conservation programs.
